Blue Hen Jobs— (formerly eRecruiting) is the University's job database for students and alumni. Students can search over 6700 employers or 224 engineering positions currently accepting applications for full-time jobs and internships— 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

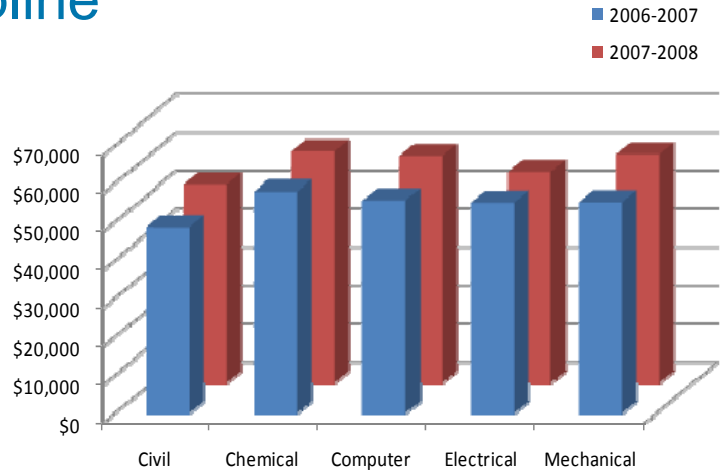
Resume Critiques

A brief survey was taken in March 2008 to determine how Students heard about the Career Services Center. The results of the survey showed that out of 553 students who responded and are registered in Blue Hen Jobs, 169 students were made aware of Career Services through faculty/classes, followed by 143 students who responded that other students made them aware and 105 responded having receiving emails from Career Service.
